 - d) Any other relevant information concerning your academic standing.
2. The applicant will be responsible for the authenticity of submitted information, other documents, and photographs. Furnishing any false information and/or suppression/ concealment of facts shall lead to rejection/ cancellation of selection/ recruitment.
