The BoG noted that as per the Statutes, the BoG Chairman has the power to send members of staff (except the Director of the Institute) for training or for a course of instruction outside India, subject to terms and conditions as may be laid by the Board from time to time. The BoG also noted that frequent requests for such approvals are disturbing the busy schedule of the BoG Chairman. Foreign travel for personal purposes by faculty or staff member using their own funds are not required to be approved by the BoG Chair. They can leave for the foreign visit after obtaining due approval from the Director and No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the Institute.

After the discussion, the following resolution was passed:

Applications for foreign travel by Faculty members for training, course of instruction, participation in conferences, research interaction and any other bona-fide academic/ research/ interaction work with funding from the Govt. of India (including CPDA and sponsored projects)/ Institute / Industry should be scrutinized by a committee constituted for the purpose, to ensure that the institutional goals are being satisfied by the faculty member travelling abroad. The faculty members may be allowed to travel abroad after approval by the Committee, followed by the Director and BoG Chair. The list of faculty members travelling abroad (with all relevant details) shall be compiled once a month, and communicated to the BoG Chair for approval. Immediately after returning from the foreign travel, the faculty member shall submit a comprehensive report to the Institute, which shall be shared with the BoG Chair (along with the list of new applications) once a month. The detailed guidelines and the process of approval for travel abroad will be shared with all faculty members.

Seven months have elapsed since the Judgment, and the Institute has received notices from the Counsel of the Complainants about filing Contempt Petitions in the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka.

"The BoG decided to appeal against the matter as the Institute Counsel's representation in the Court that the One- Man Committee report is acceptable to the Institute was factually incorrect, resulting in ex-post facto selection of a faculty to a higher post, which could have been done only by an academic committee of technical experts after examining his academic and research credentials."
