The National Institute of Technology Karnataka (NITK), Surathkal is an Institute of National Importance, established by the NITSER Act, 2007 under the Ministry of Education, Government of India. The Institute is looking for young, dynamic, tech-savvy, highly motivated, and committed postgraduates in Library and Information Science from recognized Indian universities to serve as Library Trainee purely on a temporary basis for a period of Eleven (11) months. Persons having good communication and interpersonal skills with enthusiasm and passion to learn new skills and deliver services using emerging new tools and technology will be preferred.

<b>Essential Qualification</b>	:	Master's in Library & Information Science (M.L.I.Sc) or equivalent with First Class.
<b>Nature of Traineeship</b>	:	Learn while you work on different functions & services of the library.
<b>Duration</b>	:	The duration of the traineeship will be <b>Eleven (11) months</b> .
<b>Number of Vacancies</b>	:	Five (05)
<b>Remuneration</b>	:	Consolidated Stipend of <b>Rs.15,000/-</b> per month.
<b>Age Limit</b>	:	Not exceeding 26 years. Relaxation for SC, ST, OBC (NCL), and PwD category candidates will be applicable as per Govt. of India rules.

The selected candidates will have to work six days a week and shall work in different shifts and on weekends on a rotation basis.

Selection of candidates will be based on their consistently good academic record, performance in the written test, and personal interview.

Candidates fulfilling the above requirements may send their applications in the **prescribed format** (see enclosure/attachment) along with self-attested photocopies of all certificates addressed to **The Registrar, National Institute of Technology Karnataka, Surathkal, Post Srinivasnagar, Mangaluru - 575 025**, on or before **30<sup>th</sup> June 2025**.
